In her final year of life, Chavela fulfills her last wish: to pay tribute to the Spanish poet and finally meet him in the ranks of death. The Nightingale and the Night is a documentary that chronicles the transition from Chavela's life to her death—her union with Federico dissolving the borders between reality and dreams.

Adam Garnet's first feature explores themes of love, loss, isolation and longing in a group of First Nations young people. When an adolescent girl commits suicide in a remote Northern Ontario Aboriginal community, it's up to her brother, Shane, to take care of their family. Shane was supposed to move to the city for university in the fall, and he has been trying to convince his secret boyfriend David to come with him, but now everything is uncertain. Shane is torn between his responsibilities at home and the promise of freedom calling to him from the city.




